Thanks to veterinarian Dr. Paige Vaughn and her Fix-A-Pet mobile unit, our spay/neuter clinic held at the SAP Shelter on June 26th was a success!

With the generous support of our donors, SAP was able to provide financial assistance to the families of 6 cats and 1 dog so that their pets could be seen at the clinic.. Altogether, 16 total spay/neuter procedures were performed at the SAP clinic: 9 cats and 7 dogs.

We are thankful that we can help prevent dog and cat overpopulation here in Monroe County.
